

# 3D Illustrations that are 3D

**Challenge:** Tear, Cut or Fold part of a piece of paper and integrate that into creative 3D illustration

## **Enduring Understanding:**

- Creativity and innovative thinking are essential life skills that can be developed. Creative ideas can be sparked by using materials in new ways. Artists often generate creative/humorous ideas using juxtaposition (putting things side-by-side) especially combinations that are unexpected

## **Materials:**

- a piece of paper (or another surface)
- drawing or paint media

## **Resources:**

## **Steps:**

1. Research ideas (see above)
2. You might start with
  - a. Tearing, cutting or folding part of a piece paper and see what ideas come from seeing the altered paper
  - b. Planning your idea and then tear, cut or fold part of a piece paper
3. To finish your artwork, draw objects, characters, a background or other details that clarify your concept.
4. When you have created an arrangement you like, take at least 2 PHOTOS to upload to TEAMS
  - One with YOU AND YOUR Artwork!
  - One of your Artwork (non-distracting background is best)
