

Cardboard or Chipboard Drawing

Challenge: Draw or paint on a piece of cardboard (or other brownish surface such as the chipboard from the inside of a cereal/cracker box or a brown paper bag). Use both light and dark values and consider altering the surface by tearing off the top layer of cardboard.

Enduring Understanding:

- Creativity and innovative thinking are essential life skills that can be developed. Creative ideas can be sparked working on an unusual surface.

Materials:

- Cardboard/Chipboard, Colored pencil or other drawing/painting media

Steps:

1. Research ideas (see above)
2. Select a person, place or thing to feature in your artwork
3. Lightly sketch your idea
4. Consider tearing some of the cardboard to add some interesting texture or incorporate the torn area as part of the drawing
5. Finish the drawing with pencil shading or other media. Note light values show up well on the brown surface.
6. When finished,
 - Take at least 2 PHOTOS
 - One with YOU AND YOUR Artwork!
 - One of your Artwork (non-distracting background is best)
