

Upcycle Chipboard Sculptures

How can you Transform Chipboard into a Creative Sculpture with Personal Connection?

Visual Challenge: How can you Transform Chipboard (such as Cereal Box or Toilet Paper Roll) into Art?

Enduring Understandings:

- Artists experiment with forms, structures, materials and concepts and artmaking approaches.
- Using repetition is a great way to unify an artwork and give a textural element to a sculpture

Materials: Chipboard (Toilet paper rolls, cereal/cracker boxes), old file folders, light weight cardboard, brown paper bags or other brown colored paper product or cardboard. Optional Wire, bamboo skewer, glue etc.

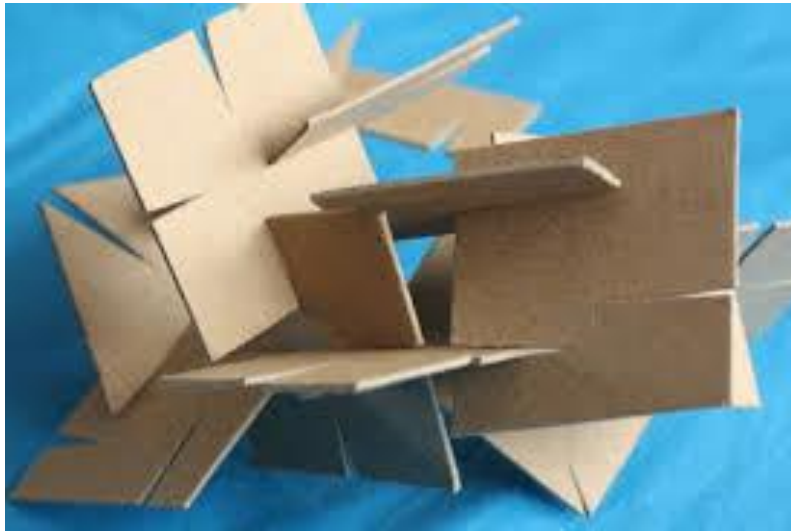


Steps

1. Research ideas s (see above)
2. Make a Mind Map of Ideas with some sketches
3. Collect materials (check your recycle bin)
4. Cut out shapes, notch as needed
5. When you have created an arrangement you like, take at least 2 PHOTOS to submit
 - One of your Artwork (with a non-distracting background)
 - One with evidence that YOU made it (you, your id card or name card)
5. Reflect on your finished artwork using the online reflection form







Notching – Use slots to join pieces

Extra Support – Use Bamboo Skewer or Toothpicks
